

How to Change the Font Size or Text Size of Website Pages: FireFox, IE, Netscape and Safari

How to Change Font Size or Text Size in FireFox Browser

1. Click on View on the browser Menu Bar.
2. Highlight Text Size with your mouse and notice that you now have 3 choices that will allow you to increase or decrease text size.
3. Increase or Decrease your font size and you will see a change in text size on this web page. You can also hold down <CTRL> and type "+" or "-" to change the font size.
4. Select Normal or <CTRL> and "0" to return to the default text size.

How to Change Font Size or Text Size in Internet Explorer Browser

1. Click on View on the browser Menu Bar.
2. Highlight Text Size with your mouse and notice that you now have 5 text size choices ranging from Largest to Smallest.
3. Click on the Size you Want and you will see a change in text size on this web page.

Change Font Size or Text Size in Netscape Browser

1. Click on View on the browser Menu Bar.
2. Highlight Text Size with your mouse and notice that you now have 3 choices that will allow you to increase or decrease text size..
3. Increase or Decrease your font size and you will see a change in text size on this web page. You can also hold down <CTRL> and type "+" or "-" to change the font size.
4. Select Normal or <CTRL> and "0" to return to the default size.

Change Font Size or Text Size in Safari Browser

1. First, open your Safari browser.

2. Click on *View* in your Safari menu, located at the top of your screen. When the drop-down menu appears, click on the option labeled *Make Text Bigger*.

3. You will notice that all of the text within the web page you are viewing has gotten larger. To increase the size again, just repeat these steps.

(Please note that you can use the following shortcut keys in lieu of clicking the menu choice: **Apple and + (Plus)**).

To Decrease:

1. Click on *View* in your Safari menu, located at the top of your screen. When the drop-down menu appears, click on the option labeled *Make Text Smaller*.

2. You will notice that all of the text within the web page you are viewing has gotten smaller. To decrease the size again, just repeat these steps.

(Please note that you can use the following shortcut keys in lieu of clicking the menu choice: **Apple and - (Minus)**).

Or Use Safari Browser Buttons to Change Text Size

The Safari browser contains two buttons which can be used to increase or decrease text size. These buttons are placed on your main toolbar, in between the *Back/Forward* navigation buttons and the *Refresh* button. They do not appear by default. You must modify your browser settings in order to make these buttons available.

1. To do this, click on *View* in your Safari menu, located at the top of your screen. When the drop-down menu appears, click on the option labeled *Text Size*.

2. You will now see two new buttons displayed on your Safari toolbar, one labeled with a small "A" and another with a bigger "A". The small "A" button, when pressed, will decrease the text size while the other button will increase it. When using these, the same behavior will occur as when you use the options detailed in Steps 2 and 3 of this tutorial.
