

ORDINANCE NO. 131 AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PAYMENT OF CERTAIN
2 PROPERTY TAXES IN A SINGLE PAYMENT.

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF EDDY COUNTY,
4 EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO:

5 Section 1. (TITLE AND PURPOSE)

6 This ordinance shall be known as, and shall be cited as,
7 "Property Taxes Required to be Paid in a Single Payment", and the
8 purpose of this ordinance is to facilitate administration of the
9 duties of County Treasurer and to eliminate certain expenses in the
10 administration and enforcement of property taxes by the County
11 Treasurer.

12 Section 2. (DEFINITIONS)

13 The definitions of words used in this ordinance are the same
14 definitions as are found and set forth in the Property Tax Code of
15 New Mexico (Articles 35 to 38 of Chapter 7, N.M.S.A. 1978), and all
16 of said definitions are incorporated herein by reference as though
17 fully set forth.

18 Section 3. (PAYMENT OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TAXES IN A SINGLE
19 PAYMENT ARE REQUIRED)

20 Unless otherwise provided in the Property Tax Code, property
21 taxes in the amount of less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) are due and
22 payable to the County Treasurer in a single payment on November 5
23 of the year in which the tax bill was prepared and mailed. No de-
24 mand for payment of property taxes is necessary.

25 Section 4. (APPLICABILITY)


26 The provisions of this ordinance are applicable to the 1983

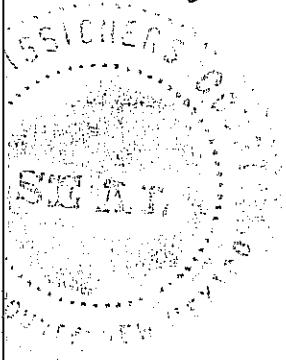
1 and subsequent property tax years. Except as expressly modified
2 herein, all provisions of the Property Tax Code shall remain in
3 full force and effect.
