



AGRICULTURAL LAND APPLICATION

Owners of agricultural property must make application to the County Assessor in which the special method of valuation is claimed. The burden of demonstrating primary agricultural use is placed on the owner of the land. This burden may be met with objective evidence of a bona fide agricultural use of the land for the year in which application is made. The value of land used primarily for agricultural purpose shall be determined on the basis of the land's capacity to produce agricultural products (NMSA 7-36-20).
